#### Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

**PK 4**: I read the book <u>Fly Guy Presents Firefighters.</u> We talked a little about fire safety.

**PK 3:** I read the book <u>Firefighters Help.</u> We talked a little about fire safety.

**Kindergarten:** I read the book <u>Stop</u>, <u>Drop</u> and <u>Roll</u>. We reviewed the character and setting part of the story. They had a worksheet where they had to put the setting with character.

**First Grade:** We worked on a nonfiction and a fiction sheet together.

**Second Grade:** They learned about how to pick a book. Things they need to look for when choosing a book to read. We also reviewed what shelf markers are and how we use them.

**Third Grade**: They will pick a science fiction book. They will have a book report due after MEA. They worked on finishing up their nonfiction discovery sheet.

**Fourth Grade**: They were introduced to historical fiction and what makes up historical fiction. They needed to pick a historical fiction book. They will do a book report on it. It will be due after MEA. Some finished up their task cards.

**Fifth/ Sixth Grade:** We reviewed metaphors, similes and personification. We then talked about onomatopoeia. They were given a personification worksheet.

**Seventh/Eighth Grade:** They will be playing a Dewey card game.
