Notes from Mrs. M & the Library! What we are learning!

PK 4: I real read the book <u>Snow</u>. This book was about how snow sounds, how it makes us feel, and it shows pictures that have many snow flakes. Ask your child if they are the same or different.

PK 3: I read the book <u>Hello, Snow.</u> This book is about all the things we can hear and see when snow comes. It also includes what we need to put on.

Kindergarten: We are now learning that the library has two kinds of books fiction and nonfiction. Fiction is pretend or fake and nonfiction is giving us information that is true. We looked at 2 different books about the same theme. They also watched a video of fiction and nonfiction.

First Grade: They reviewed the parts of a book. Today we added the glossary to the parts of a book. They learned that the glossary is like a dictionary in the back of the book. A glossary is in alphabetically order. A glossary gives us meanings for words we don't know.

Second Grade: We finished their escape room together. **Third Grade:** Finished the escape room. They learned a little about ciphers.

Fourth Grade: They are doing some research on a State that I gave them. We are using both the encyclopedia and a book about the state to answer the questions that were given to them.

Fifth and 6th Grade: We went through the figurative language test we had. I wanted this to be a learning experience so they would know the difference between all of 8 figurative language pieces.

Seventh and 8th Grade: We talked about the worksheet that they did about fact and opinion. They learned that people will give us a fact that is not right and it still is a fact and not an opinion, it was just wrong a wrong fact that we need to research. They did another fact and opinion worksheet.
