Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book <u>Good-bye Summer Hello Fall</u>. We talked about how we have 4 seasons and they each have a turn. I showed them how to say Fall and Autumn is sign language.

PK 3: I read the book <u>When Autumn Falls</u>. We talked about how the seasons change. We also talked about the 2 words that mean the same, Fall and Autumn.

Kindergarten: We talked about who characters are in a book. We also talked about who the main character is in the book. I read the story <u>Pig the Slob.</u>

First Grade: We talked about how fiction and non fiction is different. They cut and pasted what nonfiction elements are to their sheet that had a picture of the element.

Second Grade: They reviewed the call number, what is on top and what is on the bottom. They were given a work sheet where they had to add the bottom of the call number.

Third Grade: They looked for 5 different subject sections and then wrote down the number that went with the subject area they were looking at.

Fourth Grade: They worked on task cards that had items they needed to find on the shelves.

Fifth/ Sixth Grade: We continued with defining the figurative language. They took notes on Similes and Metaphors. They also had a work sheet that they needed to find the Similes on.

Seventh/Eighth Grade: They continued working on the task cards that they started last week.
