Building a Reader at Home

- ◆ Don't leave home without a book! Reading in the car and while waiting for appointments is an easy way to get some reading time.
- ◆ Encourage your child to re read favorite stories. This builds fluency, speed and accuracy.
- ◆ Dig deeper! Ask questions about what they just read. What they think will happen next.
- ◆ You read to your child and then they read to you.
- ◆ Have your child read the grocery list while you go shopping

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Preschool: Learn Parts of Book and Fall Story, & Sequence the Story

Kindergarten: Learn Parts of Book and a Fall Story

1st Grade: Alphabetizing in the Library

2nd Grade: Look for Words Used in the Library

3rd Grade: Finding Call Numbers

4th Grade: Learning to use the Encyclopedia in Teams

5/6 Grade: Start to get ideas together then write a Fable in Teams. The Moral, Setting, Characters, and Plot.

7/8 Grade: They will get books to read
