What we are learning 5/1/24!

PreK 4: I read the story by Tish Rabe, <u>My Oh, My Butterfly.</u> This story explores the life cycle of the butterfly. We introduced this book as an information book. A book that gives us things to learn/ PreK 3: I read the book <u>Splish Splash</u> this book is a book about summer fun.

Kindergarten: We are learning about medals, medals for books. They will learn a little about the Caldecott medal which a book receives for the pictures in the book. We watched a power point on the Caldecott medal.

First Grade: They went on a call number scavenger hunt. They looked for and wrote down the yellow cards placed around the room and put them in either Easy, Fiction and Nonfiction sections on their paper.

Second Grade: They started learning a little bit about the dictionary. The reasons why we use a dictionary and that it is in alphabetical order.

Third Grade: They found a word in the dictionary. They needed to state what part of speech it was, write down the definition of the word and then write a sentence using that word.

Fourth Grade: They sorted the two resources, the encyclopedia and the almanac.

Fifth/Sixth Grade: They played a game called quiet bingo. This game is the numbers of the Dewey Decimal System.

Seventh/ Eighth Grade: They were put in groups and played a game called <u>When Punctuation Takes a Vacation</u>. It is a game for citing, deleting, paraphrasing and signaling. They needed to write a correction of the card that they got.
