#### What we are learning 5/1/24!

**PreK 4:** I read the story by Kathy-Jo Wargin <u>K is for Kite.</u> This story explores all the things God gives us in Spring.

**PreK 3:** I read <u>Seasons of the Year</u> to them. This books tells us of all the four seasons that God gives us so we can do different things.

**Kindergarten**: We still talking about Jan Brett and her books. Her <u>Easter Egg</u> book gives us a chance to explore the animals that lay eggs and those who don't. 
