Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

Preschool 4's: We retold the story Sneezy. We talked about why hot things make Sneezy melt. Ask your child what Sneezy did at the end of the story.

Preschool 3's: We reviewed the reason why we bring books back when they get to take them home. I read the story All are welcome.

Kindergarten: We talked about what the author needs to put at the beginning of the story and why it is important. I read The Little Red Hen and we talked about the beginning of the story.

1st Grade: We reviewed the parts of a book. Today we looked at the title page and what things we can find on it. Then they did a worksheet on the title page.

2nd Grade: We reviewed the dictionary vocabulary words. They then opened up the dictionary to some different places to write down the things we had talked about.

3rd Grade: We will be finishing up the reasons why authors write books with a final worksheet.

4th Grade: They will be introduced to the many reference books and helps that they can use to find out information for something.

5/6 Grade: We will play a game to help them remember the 10 areas that are in the Dewey decimal system.

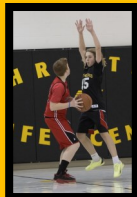
