

Notes from Mrs. M & the Library! What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book <u>One Family</u>. It talked about how at school we are in a family. I also sent home practice books. This is to help them remember to return them before they get a new one.

PK 3: I read the story <u>Minerva Louise Goes to School</u>. We talked about manners in school.

Kindergarten: They will review book care. I will read the Bad Seed Goes to the Library.

First Grade: We will review fiction and nonfiction.

Second Grade: We started with Call Numbers or addresses for books. We reviewed the two parts of the call number and where it is located.

Third Grade: They reviewed fiction, easy or everyone, and non fiction call numbers. Then they walked around the library looking for books that had them on the call numbers. They wrote them down and then we talked about them.

Seventh/ Eighth: We reviewed the Dewey Decimal System. They also answered some questions for me.
