Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book <u>God Gave Us Christmas</u>. A little cub wondered who invented Christmas. His Mom took him on a trip to show him that God is everywhere. God invented Christmas when Jesus is born. Jesus is the Light of the world.

PK 3: I read the book <u>Christmas Night Fair and Bright</u>. This is the story of Jesus's birth.

Kindergarten: We reviewed the vocabulary words on books. They then did a worksheet on some of those words. I read the story <u>A Mouse's Christmas Story.</u>

First Grade: They are working on book parts as well. We reviewed the title page information. They were then given a book where they needed to find and write down the information on the title page.

Second Grade: They continued with task cards that they needed to put into alphabetical order.

Third Grade: They looked at their mistakes on author's purpose. Then they did another sheet on author's purpose.

Fourth Grade: They looked at their mistakes on encyclopedia sheet that they did. Then they did another sheet on finding things in the encyclopedia.

Fifth/ Sixth Grade: They took a test on figurative language.

Seventh/Eighth Grade: They did a paper on Fact and Opinion. They finished up the scavenger hunt for the library.
