Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book One Winters Day. This story was about a little Hedgehog whose nest was blown away during a storm. He walked to his friends house until the storm was over. Along the way he helped 3 friends who were cold. Ask your child what happened at the end of the story.

PK 3: I read the book <u>Big Red Sled.</u> This is a story about a bear who was mad he couldn't use his sled while his Dad was sleeping. The bear got lost and he found a way home by listening to his Dad's snores.

Kindergarten: We reviewed some of the differences, then they did a worksheet on by putting books inti the right column. Then I read the book <u>Over and Under the Snow.</u>

First Grade: They reviewed what the glossary is. Then we did a worksheet together on the glossary.

Second Grade: They worked on finishing their alphabetical worksheet.

Third Grade: They did a work sheet on author's purpose. We reviewed the fact the author can have only one reason to write the article of the book.

Fourth Grade: They worked on their state report. They are using both a book on the state and the encyclopedia.

Fifth and 6th Grade: They did a escape room on figurative language. They were put into groups so they could work together. We also reviewed the figurative language before they started.

Seventh and 8th Grade: We worked on a flow chart of questions that they needed to ask themselves as they read an article to decide if it is fake news, bias, fact or opinion.
